3. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Citizens of the Commonwealth, the Economic Community of West Africa States (ECOWAS) and other nations with a reciprocal visa abolition agreement with The Cape Verde do not require a visa to enter the country on holiday or on a business trip not exceeding ninety (90) days. All other nationalities should present a visa upon arrival. However, people travelling on last-minute bookings will be allowed entry but will be required to submit their passports to the Department of Immigration in Sal Island or Praia Island within 48 hours to be issued a proper visa. Nationals who have no Cape Verde Mission in their countries are requested to send their passport details to the Focal Point of the Meeting. Arrangements will be made to receive a VISA upon arrival and a Letter from the Immigration Department will be send to such participants in relation to the VISA. This will facilitate acceptance to board by the airlines.

4. CUSTOMS

Participants' luggage may be subjected to inspection by Customs officials.

8. CLIMATE

Cape Verde is in the subtropical zone. Average temperatures range from 24°C (75°F) in January and February to 29°C (85°F) in September. The average annual rainfall for Cape Verde is 68.4 mm, with September beeing the wettest month with 33.6mm. Conversely, the months March to July record less than one millimetre of rainfall each. The climate is arid, but Cape Verde's position in the Atlantic contributes to soften the aridity, that otherwise would be the same aridity that in continental areas.

9. TIME ZONE

Greenwich Mean Time (GMT) applies in The Cape Verde.

10. VOLTAGE
